RULES FOR TABLES AND CHAIRS OUTSIDE OF COMMERCIAL PREMISES

****TABLES MUST BE 6' APART****
****STAFFERS MUST WEAR FACE COVERINGS****

No tables, chairs, benches or other items on which to sit are permitted outside of a commercial premise without the written permission of the Building Commissioner. Permission may be revoked by the Building Commissioner at any time for any reason. A denial or revocation of permission may be appealed to the City manager, whose determination shall be final.

There shall be a fee of \$25.00 per chair not to exceed \$400.00 (**FEE WAIVED FOR 2020**)

The Building Commissioner shall specify the size and number of tables and chairs, if any, that may be set up in front of or adjacent to the commercial premise, and the location of such tables and chairs. The Building Commissioner may impose such conditions as are necessary to keep pedestrian traffic flowing and minimum annoyance to neighboring businesses and residences.

There must be six (6') feet of unobstructed sidewalk for pedestrian passage.

All tables, chairs and benches placed outside the premises shall be removed each night, no later than 11:30 p.m. and placed out no earlier than 7 a.m.

At all premises where permission for tables and chairs is granted, the grantee shall name on its insurance policy the City of Long Beach as an additional insured. Liability coverage shall not be less than \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000.

No consumption of food and drink shall be permitted at such tables, chairs, benches, etc after 10:30 p.m.

Alcoholic beverages shall not be consumed at such tables and chairs except under the terms and conditions of the license issued by the New York State Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control.

Receptacles for the disposal of trash shall be placed in the immediate vicinity of the tables and chairs.

The applicant shall be responsible for the proper disposal of trash located in the receptacles and within the surrounding area of the tables, chairs and benches. The applicant shall further be responsible for obtaining and maintaining recycling bins placed in the immediate vicinity of the tables and chairs and shall be responsible for the proper disposal thereof.

The applicant shall be responsible for the proper cleaning of the sidewalk On a daily basis which shall include sweeping and washing down.

No tables and chairs shall be permitted on the boardwalk.
